Why are they still important today?</p>	<p>5) Explain how different <i>sounds</i> are made. You can use pictures and words to make yourself clear. </p>	<p>7) Design a new <i>musical instrument</i>. Can you explain why?</p>	<p>8) What is your favourite <i>song</i> and why? Write a paragraph to explain your choice. Try to include conjunctions in your writing.</p>	<p>10) Write a letter to your teacher to suggest a <i>musical instrument</i> to be taught in school. Be persuasive.</p>	<p>12) Choose a pop song and draw a picture with annotations using words from the song. </p>
