1) Write a list of artefacts from the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages with a short description.	2) Can you think of a word for each letter of the alphabet? All the words need to be based on our topic.	7) Invent an outfit for a cave man/woman thinking about the materials that would have been available.	8) Compare what life is like today to what it was like in the Stone Ages What is the same? What is different? Which age would you prefer to live in?	13) Create a cave painting that tells us a little bit about your life story.	14) Create a poster about the Stone Age. Make it colourful and informative!
3) Create a 'How to survive in the Stone Age' poster	4) Write a recount entitled 'A day in the life of a cave man/woman' What would they have done in the morning, afternoon and evening?	9) Create a comic strip of a typical day in the Stone Age.	10) What tools were used in the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages? How were they different in each era? Draw pictures of the weapons and label them in your homework book.	15) Can you make a model of Stonehenge? You could use mini boxes such as little cereal boxes or anything else you think would look good!	16) Can you make a 'Stone Age' round house and be a cave child? You could make it in your garden or build it out of old sheets in your house. Take pictures of you in it, if you're able to.
