Mathematics	<p><u>Addition and Subtraction-</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Add and subtract three 1-digit numbers - Adding with bridging - Add and subtract any two 2-digit numbers. <p><u>Multiplication and Division</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Multiplication & division facts for the 2 and 5 multiplication tables - Solve multiplication number sentences mentally or by drawing arrays. - Solve division number sentences using a pictorial method or using known multiplication facts. - Solve word problems involving multiplication and division <p><u>Fractions</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Find $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of amounts - Solve word problems involving fractions
Science	<p><u>Living Things</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Exploring and comparing things that are living, dead and never been alive.

Music	<p>Timbre and texture</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - explore different vocal timbres - explore different musical instruments - create different textures through layering - explore space and rocket sound effects
