













Learning Challenge Homework – Year 3, Spring 1 'Ancient Egypt - Weird or Wonderful?'

Find out about his discovery and summarise your findings.</p>  <p>Create your own holiday brochure, discussing all the reasons to visit Egypt. Look at major landmarks, sights, culture, food and drink, tradition and more</p>	<p>Write a letter home from a holiday in Egypt. Describe what you might have seen or been to visit.</p>  <p>Write a list of similarities and differences between Ancient Egypt and modern day Tadley- how are they different and why?</p>	<p>Create a fact file about ancient Egypt. Think about the Pyramids, the gods, food and drink, their clothing and the houses.</p> <p>Write a non-chronological report about the river Nile. Think about the cities along the river, and facts about its length and depth.</p> 	<p>Design a Tutankhamun mask. You can draw/paint/create it however, you choose.</p> <p>Sketch a picture of a pyramid, mask, jewellery, jar etc... If you were feeling inspired you could experiment with paint and other materials like clay and mod roc!</p> 	<p>Research evolution and discover what it's all about... you could even set up your own archaeology centre and dig in your back garden</p>

Can you make it rhyme?</p> 	<p>Research Egyptian Gods; study their names and what they were known for. Were there any really famous Gods, if so who were they and what did they do?</p> 	<p>Design and create your very own canopic jar, pyramid or tomb. Be as creative as you possibly can, thinking about all the materials you could use.</p>  <p>Create your own tomb or coffin for a mummy. Remember they are decorated with a picture of the person and show off their wealth.</p>	<p>Look at the different sports that may have been around at this time. Have a go at participating in one, maybe one you haven't done before. You could always set up your own outside.</p> <p>Here are some ideas - swimming, boxing, fishing, weightlifting, running, gymnastics, tug of war archery and more.</p>
