Dear Parents,

We hope that you all enjoyed your half term and found some sunshine. We are looking forward to warmer days and a little bit more spring sunshine.

Topic time

Our topic this term is “Spring has Sprung”, which the children have been very enthusiastic about so far. This topic will be focusing mainly on our aspiration 2 - How can I grow my own food and create a tasty recipe? This will involve us exploring different recipes, learning how to cook new things and planting seeds, in the hope that they will grow into something we can eat! If you have any spare seeds or items we can use with our gardening such as compost or pots, we would be very grateful.

Later in the term we will be focusing on a story about a class who make make a bee corridor. With this in mind, we will be making our own bee corridor and sharing some seeds with the local community.

Talent time

As you are aware our 3rd aspiration involves the children asking questions to help them learn how to become better artists, sports persons, writers, performers etc. It would be great to get to know any hidden talents or skills the children have. Allotment and bee walk

This term we are hoping to take the children out and around in Tadley, to visit a local allotment and to deliver seeds to the local residents to create a bee corridor. The allotment walk will take place on Tuesday 18th March from 9:00- 11:30. The seed delivery walk will take place on Tuesday 1st April from 9:00- 10:15. If anyone is available to help with walks, please can you let your child's class teacher know.

A few reminders

- **Water bottle** – reminder that they need contain water rather than squash .
- **PE kits** – Please make sure your child has a NAMED PE kit in school.
- **Reading at home** – our school expectation is that your child reads with you 3 times a weeks, which makes a significant different to your child's learning and progress. Please keep it up. #
- **Earrings and Jewellery** – Only simple studs are allowed in school. Please make sure if you child has an earring you provide some micropore tape to cover it over during PE or remove them yourself on the day. No jewellery is allowed. The children are constantly moving around and items can get lost, broken or cause an injury.
- **World Book Day** – a reminder that it is world book day next Thursday and your child is welcome to wear pj's or a book costume.
