Reading

Even though this time of year can get particularly busy, it is important to hear your child read as much as possible, and the children really do reap the rewards of regular reading. Your child will continue to bring home a reading book that matches their Monster Phonics stage. Please read these books as many times as possible with your child over the week in order to help their decoding skills and to build their fluency in reading. In addition, your child can choose a book from the book corner as a 'reading for pleasure' book. This can be read with adults at home and enjoyed together.

It is our expectation that you hear your child read **at least 3 times a week**. Please record this in your child's reading record (the 'monkey' books). **We will not change the book until it has been read three times**. Books will be changed on a **Monday**.

Homework Grid

Please find attached the homework grid for this half term. Any homework the children complete this term is optional and they will be given an opportunity to share it with the class. We have also attached a weather watching chart and a snakes and ladders common exception word reading game.

PE

As always, we ask that long hair is tied back on these days and any earrings are either taken out or covered over with medical tape. Please be mindful of sending in children with laced shoes.

Reminders

- **Water** bottles need to be in school and taken home each day to be cleaned and re-filled.
- Please ensure children have a **coat in school every day** now that it is getting colder.
- Please ensure that any new items of clothing or footwear follow the uniform policy.
