Subject	Areas Covered
Learning Enrichment	Video calling someone in Perth and asking them questions about living in Australia.
English	<p><u>Phonics</u> -Spelling rules- drop e, double rule, y to an I rule, y, al -Revision of Year 1 learning including split vowel digraphs.</p> <p><u>Reading</u> -Reading focuses include – decoding, fluency, comprehension, vocabulary and language understanding.</p> <p><u>Writing</u> -Story retelling of 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers. -Information text about an Australian animal (Quokkas). -Instruction and letter writing linked to Christmas.</p>
Mathematics	<p><u>Addition and Subtraction</u> -Add and subtract two-digit numbers. -Missing number problems.</p> <p><u>Shape</u> -Recognise 2D and 3D shapes. -Understanding side and vertices on 2D shapes. -Drawing 2D shapes -Understanding faces, edges and vertices on 3D shapes. -Lines of symmetry.</p>
Science	<p><u>Habitats</u> -What is a habitat? -Matching animals to their habitats- playing odd one out. -Inventing our own animals to suit different habitats. -Making a paper plate habitat. -Investigating micro-habitats.</p>

Geography	<p>Geographical locations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Name and locate the 7 continents and 5 oceans. -Use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the countries, continents and oceans. -Understand human and physical features. -Devise a simple map and key. -Identify seasonal daily weather patterns in the UK. -Understand geographical similarities and differences of a small area in a contrasting non-European country.
Music	<p>Pitch and Duration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Creating and performing a class version of Christmas is Coming. -Create, perform and record a carol concert.
Physical Education	<p>Balance/ agility</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Balance, agility and coordination when jumping, combining movements in a sequence and using different rolls to link sequences.
My Happy Mind	<p>Celebrate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Different character strengths that we have. -How can we learn to spot different strengths in ourselves and others. -Which character strengths do we identify with.
Religious Education	<p>Advent and Hannukah</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Understanding the significance of candles in Christianity and Judaism. (during Hannukah and Advent)
Art	<p>Aboriginal art</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Painting in the style of aboriginal art (dot painting).
Computing	<p>Digital Photography</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use a digital device to take photos. -Make choices when taking a photograph. -Describe what makes a good photo. -Decide how photos can be improved. -Use tools to change an image. -Recognise that photos can be changed.
