Stone Age

Write a list of artefacts from the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages with a short description.	Can you think of a word for each letter of the alphabet? All the words need to be based on our topic.	Invent an outfit for a cave man/woman thinking about the materials that would have been available. Remember to use adjectives to describe your outfit.	Compare what life is like today to what it was like in the Stone Ages. What is the same? What is different? Which age would you prefer to live in?	Create types of paint by crushing berries, grass, leaves and other natural materials. Use the paint to create a cave painting that tells us a little bit about your life story.	Can you make a model of Stonehenge? You could use mini boxes such as little cereal boxes or anything else you think would look good!
Create a 'How to survive in the Stone Age' poster	People in the Stone Age used marks when they were counting. Can you count how many toys or books you have and use tally marks to record this? Create a table and tally up some of the objects around your home.	Create a comic strip of a typical day in the Stone Age.	Create a Venn Diagram of modern tools, Stone Age tools and tools that were created during the Stone Age that we still use today.	Measure like a cave child! Use natural objects like sticks and rocks to measure how long objects are.	Can you make a 'Stone Age' round house and be a cave child? You could make it in your garden or build it out of old sheets in your house. Take pictures of you in it, if you're able to.

One piece of learning challenge homework must be completed each week ready to be handed in each **Friday**. You can stick it in to your green Home Learning Book. Please feel free to make and create things that cannot be recorded in your book! You only need to do one of these every week.
