Materials that would be useful are: cupcake cases, string, plastic bag and bits of cardboard.</p>	<p>Design and make your very own Mediterranean menu! Be as creative as you like!!</p>	<p>Using PowerPoint or word, make an E Safety poster. Find out the important facts about staying safe online.</p>
<p>Pretend you're at a Mediterranean market and you have €20 (20 Euros) to spend. What do you buy?</p>	<p>Choose a Mediterranean country and research the average weather temperature for the year. Could you plot the data on a graph?</p>	<p>Research 5 different Mediterranean countries and write their names down. Count how many letters are in each name and create a bar chart to show your results.</p>	<p>Plan your very own holiday to the Mediterranean and create a timetable for your first day. Don't forget getting to the airport in time for your flight!</p>	<p>Look at some famous landmarks from different countries in the Mediterranean. What shapes can you see that each landmark is made of? Draw one landmark using 2D shapes.</p>
