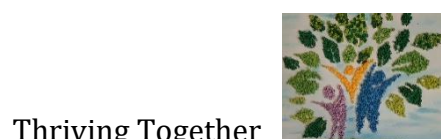

Subject	Areas Covered
Learning Enrichment	Planning and enjoying a healthy picnic with our parents Rehearsing and performing for the leaver’s assembly A trip to Four Kingdoms, Action Farm
English	<p>Phonics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Spelling rules- revising all homophones and digraphs - Vowel suffix rules- drop e, double consonant, y to an i - Revision- split vowel digraphs (a_e, e_e, i_e, o_e, u_e) - Common exception words – reading and spelling <p>Reading:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Reading focuses include – comprehension, fluency, vocabulary and language understanding, predicting and making inferences <p>Writing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sentence types and punctuation linked to ‘Dear Earth’ - Sequencing events and fiction writing linked to the text ‘Flotsam’ - Poetry – children will write poems using descriptive vocabulary collected from books read -Letter writing linked to the text ;the Day the Crayons Quit’
Mathematics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Time (o’clock, half past, quarter to/past, 5 minutes, minutes in an hour, hours in a day) -Statistics (make tally charts, tables, block diagrams, draw and interpret pictograms) -Position and direction (language of position, describe movement, describe turns, shape patterns with turns)
Science	<p>Healthy Living</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Understand that we can have an impact on our environment - Describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air) - Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene - Find out about different food groups and balanced diets

Art	<p><u>Fruit and Vegetables</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Investigate the work of artist Arcimboldo - Create our own art in his style - Use a range of recycled materials to design and make our own products
Design and Technology	<p><u>Make a healthy picnic</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use the basic principles of a healthy and varied diet to prepare dishes -Understand where food comes from
Music	<p><u>Focus on Pitch and Performance</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use our voices expressively and creatively by singing songs - Rehearsing and performing - Listening and responding
Physical Education	<p><u>Gymnastics</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Turning jumps. - Rolling on the floor in different ways and in different directions - Finding different body parts upon which to spin - Turning in the air, on the floor and on apparatus - Twisting - learning that one part of the body is fixed as the other part moves to create a twist and be able to move out of it - Join movements together to make a sequence
Computing	<p><u>Programming Quizzes</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Begin to understand that sequences of commands have an outcome. - Make predictions based on our learning - Modify designs to create our own quiz questions in ScratchJr - Evaluate our work and make improvements to our programming projects.
