Write an acrostic poem using either the word EVOLUTION, FOSSILS or DINOSAUR – each line must contain a description or information about the about the subject.	Write a diary entry as either: A palaeontologist who has discovered a new fossil OR A biologist who has discovered a new living species.	Draw a picture showing the variety of life on Earth. It should be detailed and carefully done. You can use the examples below to copy or create your own.
