Home Learning Suggested Timetables

Our home learning packs/website activities for each year group contain English, Maths and other curriculum subject activities for the children to complete. There are also useful websites and some other fun activities that the children may enjoy doing whilst not attending school.

We are not setting 6 hours of home learning a day as this would be unmanageable for teachers to resource and for you to deliver. The home learning packs are designed to help the children to revise and consolidate prior learning, whilst providing structure and activities that will hopefully engage the children during their absence. Most children like, and benefit from routine; therefore, we suggest trying to stick to a set structure when completing the work. Using the structure below may be useful:

1st Activity: Phonics

Movement break

2nd Activity: English

Break

3rd Activity: Maths

Break

4th Activity: Other

At some point in the day – read with your child.

If it is appropriate, your child may find it easier to complete tasks in a practical way. When completing tasks also consider if it is necessary for your child to write, you could record things in a different way or scribe ideas for your child at times. Before completing any writing tasks, your child may find it helpful to create a word bank of possible ideas that they may include.

The packs will be available on the school's website under each year group's tab. We will update the packs every Friday for the following week. We will make hardcopies of the packs available every Monday morning outside the school office for parents to collect if accessing the packs electronically is a problem.

If your child has an SEN need that effects their ability to access the home learning, Miss Stevens will be writing to you to share what plans we have in place for your child.

Please be aware the list is suggested activities for the week ahead. Don't forget to continue reading at home regularly, both reading to an adult and enjoying books together. On the school's website is an additional list with a range of websites you can access for further ideas and reading texts.
