<p>Practise your handwriting. Concentrate on forming your letters correctly. Think about the handwriting rhymes to help.</p>	<p>Look at pictures of didgeridoos and listen to the sound. Design, make and decorate a didgeridoo using aboriginal decorations.</p>	<p>Research famous landmarks in Australia. Which would you rather visit? Create a fact sheet or poster</p>
