Year 2	Term – Summer 1 2022 – Beaches in the UK. ‘Beside the Seaside’
Subject	Areas Covered
Learning Enrichment	Outdoor afternoon linked to planting and growing science topic
English	<p><u>Phonics</u> Spelling rules- dge, g, c, kn, gn, wr, le, il, el, al, homophones Vowel suffix rules- drop e, double consonant, y to an i Revision- split vowel digraphs (a_e, e_e, i_e, o_e, u_e)</p> <p><u>Reading:</u> Reading focuses include – decoding, fluency, comprehension, vocabulary and language understanding</p> <p><u>Writing:</u> -Letter and diary writing linked to ‘The Day the Crayons Quit’ -Non-fiction writing in the form of a leaflet- advertising a trip to the beach. -Poetry – children will write their own seaside poems using alliteration and repetition -Narrative writing based on ‘The Lighthouse Keeper’s Lunch’</p>
Mathematics	<p><u>Addition and Subtraction-</u> -Add and subtract any 2digit numbers using a blank number line or by drawing dienes. -Solve word problems involving addition and subtraction</p> <p><u>Multiplication and Division</u> -Multiplication & division facts for the 2 and 5 multiplication tables -Solve multiplication number sentences mentally or by drawing arrays. Solve division number sentences using a pictorial method or by using known multiplication facts. - Solving word problems involving multiplication and division</p> <p><u>Fractions</u> -Find $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$s $\frac{1}{3}$s, $\frac{2}{4}$s and $\frac{3}{4}$s of amounts -Solve word problems involving fractions</p>
Science	<p><u>Planting and Growing-</u> -make predictions about how seeds will grow and researching what plants need to stay healthy. -plant bean seeds- checking on these daily and writing a plant diary - investigate plant reproduction by making our own ‘helicopter seeds’.</p>
Design and Technology	-design, make and evaluate a ‘Beach in a box’
