PSED	Communication & Language
Children will have lots of opportunities to get to know the other children and adults in the school. They will play a range of 'getting to know you' games and learning our school rules.	There will be a range of speaking and listening opportunities for children to get to know other and learn how we listen in school. They will also have the chance to talk about themselves in a range of different circumstances.
Physical development	Reading & Writing
The children will have the chance to explore our outdoor area, as well as learn about P.E in school. They will develop their fine motor movements through dough gym and 'pinchy finger' activities.	The children will be exposed to a wide range of different songs, rhymes and stories that they can join in with. We will be introducing them to our phonics system (learning how to read and write).
Understanding of the world	Maths
Children will learn about their own bodies, especially through their senses. They will also be able to talk about their own likes and dislikes and who they are as a person, using our "All about me" sheets to help.	Regular counting aloud, careful 1-to-1 counting correspondence and recognising number to 10 and beyond. The children will also practise sorting objects, comparing amounts and exploring patterns.
Expressive Arts	How to help at home
During this term, the children will have the chance to explore all the different media and materials we have to offer at school. They can choose what they would like to make to create different 2D and 3D models.
