<b>PSED</b>	<b>Communication &amp; Language</b>
Children will be encouraged to be as independent as they can during this term, both in learning and organisational skills. They will be learning about dental hygiene and healthy food to eat.	The children will be working with others practising speaking and listening skills. They will also be encouraged to use good concentration skills during carpet times.
<b>Physical development</b>	<b>Reading &amp; Writing</b>
During P.E we will be completing different themed PE weeks to help develop core skills such as balancing and core strength in Real PE. Children will also be working on their pencil grip and letter formation during handwriting practise.	During our new monster phonics children will continue to learn new digraph sounds and use them to read and write simple words and sentences. Children will be encouraged to form letters correctly and begin to form simple sentences.
<b>Understanding of the world</b>	<b>Maths</b>
Children will have the opportunity to see what happens to eggs as they develop and hatch into chicks. They will also learn about planting and growing. They will be exploring the world around them through the plants we are growing. We will also be exploring the Easter festival.	Children will be learning numbers to 20 during magic maths, Children will develop their understanding of number pairs (bonds) to 5 and beyond. We will also be looking at shapes and patterns in the environment.
<b>Expressive Arts</b>	<b>How to help at home</b>
The children will have the chance to explore a range of different materials and media. They will be trying observational drawing of plants as well as learning how to use different media like chinks, pastels and the computer to make different images.
