Day 1 To know that stories have problems in them. You will then draw your favourite part from the story.
Day 2 To sing and map a story. Then you will create a story map to help you remember the important parts in the story. Could you share your story map with someone at home?

Then you will listen to the story one last time, remembering that your task for today is to tell someone in your house the story with actions and voices.
