How was Britain affected by WWII



Create a poster encouraging men to go and fight in the war - see if you can find any inspiration for this online!



Write a letter home to your family as an evacuee from Basingstoke/Tadley who has been sent to the countryside. Describe how life is different.



Learn some words linked to the war in another language and write down some words or phrases in your book (this could be in French, German or Italian).



Create a gas mask. Look online for ideas of what

they looked like and even

ideas of how to make one!

Write a set of instructions on how to make an air raid shelter (you will find pictures and ideas online or use your imagination).

Think about what you will need, building in a logical order etc.



Write a poem about the war, a soldier or an evacuee.

Can you make it rhyme? Does it have to?



Research different aeroplanes used in WWII. Draw a detailed diagram or see if you can recreate one from household objects.



See if you can find a recipe for a WW2 meal. You can make the meal, take photos of yourself making it and write about what you did. You can even bring some in to school to share/show.



Create your own piece of music linked to the war. You can share this with us through a live performance or video. You could write your own song or rap in your book.







Research how WW2 affected your family. You could interview relatives. look at old photos etc. Write a report on how WW2 affected your family or write an interview with a family member who was affected.
